

Carmine Mucci Killed by Rock Fall in Cascade Shaft

Carmine Mucci, one of the best known of the Italian residents of this place, was instantly killed by a fall of rock while employed in the Cascade shaft. The accident occurred about three o'clock last Friday afternoon and came without warning. Death was instantaneous. 5-1917-11-30

The deceased was a man of 34 years and had resided here for the past ten years. He had taken an active part in the activities of societies in this section and was a member of The Sons of Italy, Moose Lodge, Independent Italian Society and of the U. M. W. of A. He had devoted much of his time in the interest of these organizations and his absence will be keenly felt.

The deceased is survived by wife, who was formerly Mary Del Principe, five sons and two daughters. Impressive funeral services were conducted in the Soldier Catholic church by Rev. John Lorenz of of Helvetia, at 2 o'clock last Sunday afternoon, with interment in the Soldier Hill cemetery. L. H. Reed was the undertaker in charge.
