

Last Will of John Rudolf Blum.

I, John Rudolf Blum, of the town of New Glarus County of Green State of Wisconsin, being of sound mind and memory and mindful of the uncertainties of human life do hereby declare this to be my last will and testament in manner following:

After the payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Fanny Klausner the sum of fifty Dollars (\$50.)

All the remainder and residue of all my property I give and bequeath to my daughter Fanny Worder, and I hereby revoke a former will by me made.

I appoint Dr. J. J. Blumer executor of this my last will.
